### Call for the selection of no. 1 short-term Research Associate position:

The University of Pisa announces the public selection for the assignment of n. 1 research activities grant (hereinafter referred as Research Grants):

"Analysis of biomedical signals and clinical biomarkers in physical, emotional and cognitive stress conditions" at the Department of Information Engineering

Scientific Sector ING-INF/06 - Electronic and informatics bioengineering

Contract duration: 12 months

Gross annual salary: € 21.983,20

# Admission requirements:

PhD or equivalent academic qualification awarded abroad **or** Medical Specialty School qualification. All qualifications shall be awarded by the interview's date.

## **Applications:**

Applications are to be submitted online only, using the following link: <a href="https://pica.cineca.it/unipi/">https://pica.cineca.it/unipi/</a> or shall be invalid. It is necessary to have an email address to login and complete the application.

Applicants should fill in all the required data and upload all documents in PDF format.

The system allows saving a draft of the application within the application deadline. The system will register the online application date and send a receipt with an automatic e-mail reply. After the deadline, the system will not allow login nor application submission.

To be valid, application shall include all the required data, applicant's signature and the copy of a valid ID.

Each application will be assigned a tracking number to be cited in all subsequent communications, together with the selection code provided by the application form.

Applicants undertake to communicate in writing any variations of what declared in the application form.

The communication shall be edited in PDF format, signed and forwarded to the University of Pisa Rector via the Italian certified e-mail system address ( P.E.C. Posta Elettronica Certificata): <a href="mailto:protocollo@pec.unipi.it">protocollo@pec.unipi.it</a> or via e-mail at: <a href="mailto:concorsi\_assegni@unipi.it">concorsi\_assegni@unipi.it</a>, by the deadline for submitting the application.

Applicant's valid identification document shall be annexed.

Applications shall be completed with the following annexes:

- 1. A self-attested Curriculum of the personal didactics, teaching and scientific activities, dated and signed;
- 2. The qualifications applicant considers eligible for this selection;
- 3. The Publications applicant considers eligible for this selection;
- 4. A list of Publications and qualifications, dated and signed;
- 5. A copy of the fiscal code (if applicable) and identification card/passport;

All publications should not exceed 30 megabyte and are to be submitted in PDF format <u>only</u>, using the specific section of the application form.

If the file produced exceeds that size, it is possible to forward it by PEC (the Italian certified e-mail system address) to <a href="mailto:protocollo@pec.unipi.it">protocollo@pec.unipi.it</a> with reference to the application.

Publications must be uploaded.

#### Selection procedure:

For each selection procedure, the Director of the Department concerned will appoint a Committee, consisting of three members.

The selection is assessed by qualifications and possible interview.

The total rating allowed is 100/100. Academic qualifications and publications will be assigned up to 90 points. The interview will be assigned up to 10 points, with a minimum passing rate of 6/10. The ranking list will be compiled considering both ratings.

The Committee might resolve to interview candidates in the event:

- the qualifications and publications assessment doesn't result in an exhaustive outcome or
- candidates have been admitted under condition and the Committee shall verify the awarding of the PhD or any equivalent qualification obtained abroad, or, when required, the Medical Specialty School qualification.

The possible interview, related to the research program, will be held "in-presence" on 20<sup>th</sup> January 2021 at 9 am in Pisa.

During the two days before the interview's date, candidates are requested to check the relevant page on the University website <a href="https://www.unipi.it/ateneo/bandi/assegni/2020/index.htm">https://www.unipi.it/ateneo/bandi/assegni/2020/index.htm</a> in order to verify:

- whether the committee resolved on the interview: all instructions for the "in-presence" interview in accordance with the Safety Protocol against Covid-19 Spread. Guidelines for "in-presence" Selection Procedures, along with the specific location where the interview will take place and/or further information about the possible postponement of the interview's date;
- whether the committee resolved not to carry out the interview: the related explanatory statement.

Candidates living abroad, and therefore unable to attend the interview at the University of Pisa, will be allowed to be interviewed via web or conference call, prior to applicant's identification by approved international universities or research centers and upon Selection Committee approval. The Selection committee is appointed to establish the duly examination of the candidates and shall acquire each candidate's copy of an identity card or passport.
