## Call for the selection of no. 1 short-term Research Associate position:

The University of Pisa announces the public selection for the assignment of n. 1 research activities grant (hereinafter referred as Research Grants):

at the Department of Mathematics

Contract duration: 12 months

Gross annual salary: € 32.567,70

### Admission requirements:

Master degree and a professional scientific CV relevant for the research activities. All qualifications shall be awarded by the application's deadline.

#### **Applications:**

Applications are to be submitted online only, using the following link: <a href="https://pica.cineca.it/unipi/">https://pica.cineca.it/unipi/</a>

or shall be invalid. It is necessary to have an email address to login and complete the application.

Applicants should fill in all the required data and upload all documents in PDF format.

The system allows saving a draft of the application within the application deadline. The system will register the online application date and send a receipt with an automatic e-mail reply. After the deadline, the system will not allow login nor application submission.

To be valid, application shall include all the required data, applicant's signature and the copy of a valid ID.

Each application will be assigned a tracking number to be cited in all subsequent communications, together with the selection code provided by the application form.

Applicants undertake to communicate in writing any variations of what declared in the application form.

The communication shall be edited in PDF format, signed and forwarded to the University of Pisa Rector via the Italian certified e-mail system address ( P.E.C. Applications shall be completed with the following annexes:

- 1. A self-attested Curriculum of the personal didactics, teaching and scientific activities, dated and signed;
- 2. The qualifications applicant considers eligible for this selection;
- 3. The Publications applicant considers eligible for this selection;
- 4. A list of Publications and qualifications, dated and signed;
- 5. A copy of the fiscal code (if applicable) and identification card/passport;

All publications should not exceed 30 megabyte and are to be submitted in PDF format <u>only</u>, using the specific section of the application form.

If the file produced exceeds that size, it is possible to forward it by PEC (the Italian certified e-mail system address) to <a href="mailto:protocollo@pec.unipi.it">protocollo@pec.unipi.it</a> with reference to the application.

Publications must be uploaded.

### Selection procedure:

For each selection procedure, the Director of the Department concerned will appoint a Committee, consisting of three members.

The selection is assessed by qualifications and interview.

The interview will be aimed at assessing whether the candidate is provided with adequate knowledge of the topics relating to the scientific field that underlies the research programme, as well as aptitude and potential for the programme development.

The total rating allowed is 100/100. Academic qualifications and publications will be assigned up to 60 points. The interview will be assigned up to 40 points, with a minimum passing rate of 24/40. The ranking list will be compiled considering both ratings.

No more than no. 6 candidates are admitted to the interview. In this event, according to the scores assigned in the qualifications and publications assessment, the Committee will admit to the interview the candidates obtaining the six top scores, plus those having obtained a score equal to the candidate ranked as sixth in the preliminary ranking, if any.

The interviews will be held remotely using a video meeting platform, on 21st June 2021 at 9.00 am and on 22nd June 2021.
