

SELECTION PROCEDURE FOR THE FUNCTION OF SUPERVISING VETERINARIAN AT THE NETHERLANDS FOOD and CONSUMER PRODUCT SAFETY AUTHORITY (NVWA – DUTCH GOVERNMENT)

STEP 1: SIGN UP

When you are interested in this position the employment agency Vetwork will introduce you to the NVWA as a candidate.

STEP 2: ENGLISH LANGUAGE ASSESSMENT

You will receive an English language assessment from Vetwork to determine your English language skills.

After completing your test send the answer sheet to dutchathome@hotmail.nl. Dutch@home will review your test and inform the NVWA about the result. An interview via Skype is optional, if so you will be invited by Dutch@home. After the test is reviewed the employment agency will contact you and share the outcome: positive or negative. A positive outcome is necessary to proceed in the application procedure.

STEP 3: E-ASSESSMENT OF CAPABILITIES

After a positive outcome of the English language test you will be registered at Leeuwendaal. Leeuwendaal will contact you to make an appointment for a psychological e-assessment. They will provide you with all necessary information about the procedure of this assessment.

A psychological assessment is a process of testing that uses a combination of techniques to give information about a person and their behavior, personality and capabilities. It is used to provide extra information about a candidate and his or her motives.

The result of the assessment will be evaluated by a psychological advisor of Leeuwendaal in a Skype interview with you. You will receive a report of the results of the assessment and give permission to share this report with the NVWA. The NVWA uses the report to evaluate whether you may proceed to the next selection step in the application procedure.

STEP 4: JOB INTERVIEW

Step four is a job interview with the NVWA via Skype. You will be invited for this interview by your employment agency Vetwork. Afterwards, Vetwork will notify you about the outcome.

1 APRIL 2019

The intensive Dutch language course in Wageningen starts at the 1st of April 2019. This course is aimed at achieving level B2, a requirement for entering the substantive training program. A room at the WICC Wageningen will be available for you during the length of this course. During the language course you will receive support in finding a home in the area where you will be stationed (in the north or east of the Netherlands).

The substantive training program (indicated duration 6 months) to become a supervising veterinarian at the NVWA starts in September. The indicated 6 months is a guideline, the actual duration of the training period depends on your development and your total number of working hours.

- Essere disposto a trasferirti in Olanda;

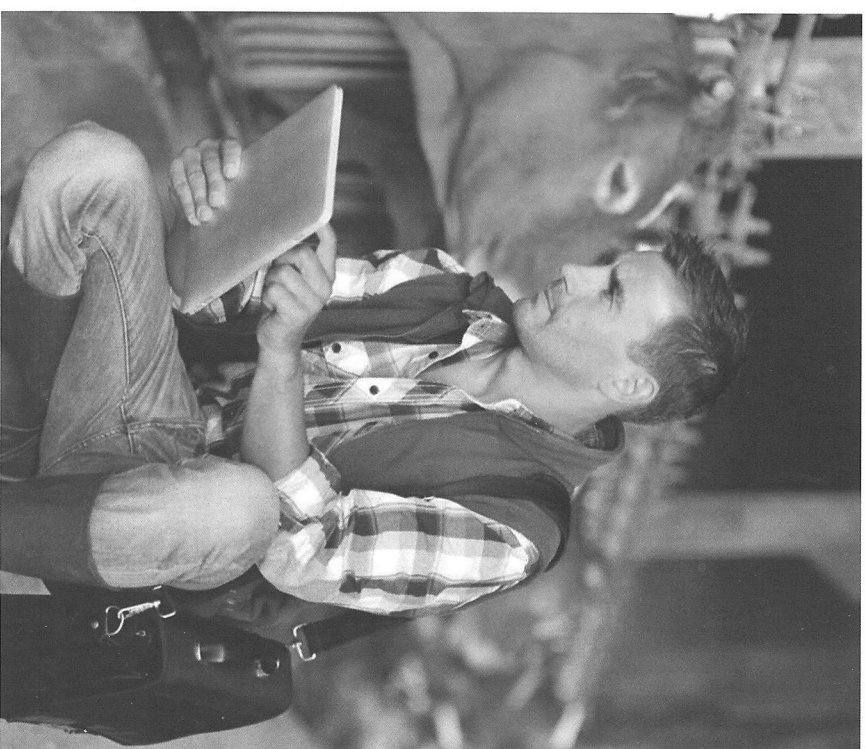
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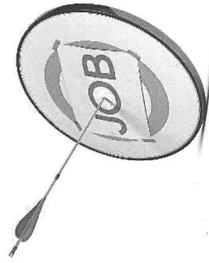

As a supervising veterinarian (practitioner) you will monitor food safety and animal welfare. This includes ensuring compliance in abattoirs, animal transport, import and export certification of products with animal origin. Depending on workload you will be deployed to small, medium, and large abattoirs (red meat and/or poultry). You will also visit primary companies, export collection centers and cold stores. The Dutch government has a dedicated team of trained and skilled veterinary auditors who carry out compliance audits on a scheduled (announced) basis. Are you their new team member?

Veterinarian on a greyhound track in England

You are responsible for the 'vetroom', pre-kenneling inspection, where needed perform a full clinical examination, and inspection of track (not waterlogged, frozen, or inconsistent, no obstacles on track etc.)

Learn the language

Certificate

Important documents and belongings

As well as your passport remember to bring other important documents or belongings with you to the Netherlands, f.e. your driving license, prescription medication and/or proof of degree.

Register as a (temporary) resident

When you have registered as a resident you will receive a Citizen Service number. You will need this number, for example for: • work. • a bank account. • the general practitioner or hospital. • your children's school.

Set up a bank account

Banks normally require two documents: one to prove your identity (passport of EU identity card) and one to prove your address.

Health insurance

Medical care is not free, but many costs will be covered by a health insurance. In the Netherlands it is mandatory to have this kind of insurance. Vetwork can advise you on this matter.
