Starting from January 2017, your University will be part of UBORA, a project for creating an EU-African virtual Infrastructure for open source co-design of new solutions to face the current and future healthcare challenges of both continents. UBORA will combine networking, knowledge on rapid prototyping of new ideas and sharing of designs, blueprints, safety criteria and performance data. Specific sections for needs identification, project management, repositories and fund raising are foreseen.

UBORA ("excellence" in Swahili) brings together European and African Universities and their associated technological hubs (supporting biomedical prototyping laboratories and incubators), national and international policymakers and committed and credible stakeholders propelled by a series of Summer Schools and Competitions.

The author of the winning logo will be invited to present her/his work during the press conference on January 17th 2017. A certificate will be awarded to the winner.
