


## SC7 – Secure societies

### Protecting freedom and security of Europe and its citizens




All actions under the 2018-2020 Work Programme (WP) of the Societal Challenge 7 contribute to the Focus Area<sup>1</sup> [“Boosting the effectiveness of the Security Union”](#), which will support implementation of the Security Union priorities and help tackling the challenges that Europe is facing in:

- **protecting infrastructure** against natural and man-made threats, including **cyber-attacks**;
- improving **resilience to natural and man-made disasters**;
- fighting **crime and terrorism**;
- improving **border security**;
- **digital security** and privacy; and
- better **understanding of societal contexts and dynamics**.



At the core of research is the **development of new technologies** or applying emerging technologies to meet the needs of security practitioners, but it also requires **understanding phenomena**. Thus social sciences and humanities will be fully involved. The approach taken in 2016-17 WP requiring [a minimum number of practitioners<sup>2</sup>](#) in a consortium is continued. The topics of SC7 are grouped within the following **3 CALLS**:



Please note that several sub-calls include an **open topic**. It requires the involvement of a large number of practitioners (i.e. 5 instead of 3, as in pre-defined topics).

<sup>1</sup> Focus Areas are implemented as ‘virtual calls’, which constitute the linking of specific calls/topics from the different parts of Horizon 2020.

<sup>2</sup> When a reference is made to “practitioners”, the text refers to someone who is qualified or registered to practice a particular occupation, profession in the field of security or civil protection.

# PROTECTING THE INFRASTRUCTURE OF EUROPE AND THE PEOPLE IN THE EUROPEAN SMART CITIES

Threats against crowded areas and disruptions in the operation of EU infrastructure may limit the liberties of citizens and put at risk the functioning of societies and their economies. The security and resilience of Europe critical infrastructure needs to be ensured because disruptions in their operations may entail the collapse of large sectors of our activities. Threats to soft targets such as crowded areas may have less long-term physical impact, but may be highly damaging due to potentially large numbers of victims and subsequent psychological and sociological impacts.

## SECURITY

All the three sub-calls have a first topic on **human factors and the societal aspects** related to the issue at stake (disasters and resilience; crime and terrorism; border security). The social and societal dimension of new technologies and policies should be taken into account and understood, whilst respecting fundamental rights, including privacy, protection of personal data and the free movement of persons. In particular, the sub-calls aim at:

1. advancing innovation in the society at large, and among first responders<sup>3</sup> to **reduce the loss of human life and to reduce environmental, economic and material damage from natural and man-made disasters**, including from **climate-related weather events**, earthquakes and volcanic events, **space weather events**, **industrial disasters**, **crime and terrorism threats**.
2. mitigating potential consequences of crime- and/or terrorism-related incidents or to avoid them. New technologies and capabilities should address the fight against and the **prevention of crime (including cyber-crime)**, illegal trafficking and terrorism (including cyber-terrorism and CBRN-E attacks), along with understanding and tackling terrorist ideas and beliefs.
3. strengthening security through **border management**, on **land** and in the **maritime** domain, enhancing the use of new technology for border checks, also in relation to the [Smart Borders](#) initiative, whilst respecting fundamental rights including free movement of persons, protection of personal data, and privacy.

An additional call is dedicated to **practitioners** interested in the uptake of **security research and innovation**. They are invited to associate in **networks and PCPs** in the field security in order to allocate time and resources to monitor innovation and research that could be useful to them, and to involve their respective procurement bodies in preparing for future acquisitions.
