



Call Consolidator@UNIPi 2026

Art. 1 – Purpose and object of the call

The University of Pisa offers a **support service** to researchers interested in presenting proposals for the call **ERC Consolidator Grant 2027** (ERC-2027-CoG), whose opening is the 22nd of July 2026 with deadline the 14th of October 2026.

The support will consist of an extensive and interactive review process on:

- CV and scientific profile of the PI
- project idea and its presentation

and will be carried out by a consultancy agency selected by the University of Pisa in collaboration with the Research Development Unit.

Art. 2 – Recipients of the call

The applicants are researchers, of any nationality, interested in presenting a project proposal for the ERC Consolidator Grant 2027 call, selecting the University of Pisa as the Host Institution. It is not required to be under contract with UNIPi.

Art. 3 – Eligibility criteria

The eligibility criteria are defined in agreement with the ERC-2027-CoG Work Programme:

- researchers are eligible to apply for a Consolidator Grant if they have successfully defended their PhD between five and fifteen years prior to the 1st of January 2027¹.
- researchers who have received a **C score at Step 1** in the ERC calls published under the Work Programmes 2025 and 2026 for Starting, Consolidator and Advanced grants cannot apply to the 2027 ERC CoG grant call
- researchers who have received a **B score at Step 1** in the ERC calls published under the Work Programmes 2026 for Starting, Consolidator and Advanced grants cannot apply to the 2027 ERC CoG grant call
- researchers whose proposal was rejected on the ground of a breach of research integrity cannot apply to the 2027 ERC CoG grant call

¹ Successful defence of PhD in between January 1st 2012 and December 31st 2021 (inclusive). Extensions of eligibility are possible in the case of maternity leave, paternity or parental leave, long term illness, national service, disability, clinical training, major disasters, seeking asylum, gender-based violence or any other form of violence. PhD defence date: the reference date is the certified date of the successful defence (and not award) of the PhD. Whenever the PhD certificate does not show the PhD defence date, applicants should provide a written confirmation from the awarding institution stating the said date.

In addition, an internal criterium was added: researchers having had access to the support service in the Consolidator@UNIPi 2025 edition are not eligible to this call. This limitation does not apply to researchers having had access to the service in previous editions.

Art. 4 – How to submit the application and deadline

The applicants are required to submit the CV and the project idea, together with a “Letter of Acknowledgment” signed by the Director of the Department of the University of Pisa that will host the researcher if he/she is the winner of the ERC-CoG 2027. Both digital and wet signature are accepted.

All documents must be written in **English** and provided in **pdf format**.

Applicants are required to register here <https://survey.unipi.it/applicant/consolidator/index.php>. Registration provides access to the submission wizard, where applicants can fill in the required fields and upload Annexes 1 and 2. Proposals submitted through any other channel will not be accepted.

The deadline for the submission of applications is **15 September 2026 at 11:59 pm**.

Applicants will receive a **confirmation email** acknowledging successful submission, including the **ID** assigned to their proposal, which will be used for future communications. No additional confirmation mail will be sent by the UNIPi Unit office in charge of the initiative.

Art. 5 – Evaluation procedure

Applications to Consolidator@UNIPi call will be reviewed by an Evaluation Committee, coordinated by the Vice-Chancellor for the Promotion of Research (representative for the PE domain) and also composed of the Delegate for research in Life Sciences and the Delegate for research in Social Sciences and Humanities. The Committee may be supported by expert evaluators in the scientific areas of the submitted proposals.

The members of the Committee and the experts are obliged to maintain the confidentiality of information relating to the proposals that will be submitted to them for evaluation.

Art. 6 – Evaluation criteria

Project ideas will be evaluated based on the sole criterion of scientific excellence for a maximum score of 80/100. Up to a maximum of 20/100 points will be assigned to the candidate's profile that has to be in line with the requirements of the ERC-CoG-2027 call. Proposals reaching a threshold of 70/100 will be selected.

Art. 7 – Publication of the results

Upon completion of the evaluation process, the list of **maximum 10** proposals eligible for funding will be published on the University's web page dedicated to the call <https://www.unipi.it/en/research/support-and-incentives/ercunipi/consolidatorunipi-2025-the-call-to-support-your-application-for-the-erc-consolidator-grant/>

Personal data will be processed solely for the purposes of this call for proposals.

The “Direzione Ricerca e Valorizzazione delle Conoscenze”, the members of the evaluation committee and the experts agree not to disclose the contents of project proposals to third parties and to protect the confidentiality of everything stated therein.
