### **Bordatino alla pisana**



*Kind of "polenta" enriched with black cabbage and beans*

### **Cecina**



*Chickpea flour, water, oil, salt, pepper*

### **Trippa alla pisana**



*Tripe, tomato, onions and bacon*

### **Pappa al pomodoro**



*Stale Tuscan bread and tomatoes*

### **Minestra di pane**



*Stale Tuscan bread, carrots, potatoes, savoy and black cabbage, spinach, cannellini and borlotti beans, tomato puree, extra virgin olive oil, celery, garlic, onions, parsley*

### **Mucco pisano**



*Pisan cow steak*

### **Torta co' bischeri**



*Tart with chocolate, rice, sultanas, pine nuts and candied fruit*

# SHOPPING

In Pisa, one of the main landmarks for shopping is the long and central Corso Italia, which connects Piazza Vittorio Emanuele II to Via di Banchi, to the adjacent Piazza XX Settembre and the nearby Ponte di Mezzo.

This bridge is ideally the centre of the city and is the oldest of the five ones that connect the two Pisan banks of the Arno. Corso Italia is home to shops of all types and for all budgets, from prestigious artisan workshops to goldsmiths, bookshops and large clothing and accessories shops.



Borgo Stretto

Beyond the Arno, Piazza Garibaldi leads to Borgo Stretto, with its typical arcades, and from here to Via Oberdan, also known as Borgo Largo.

The boutiques of the most famous Italian and international designers are concentrated in this area, as well as the most renowned restaurants and food and wine speciality shops, where it is possible to taste and purchase all the best traditional local products.

Not far from Borgo Stretto and its elegant shops, the 16th-century arcade of Piazza delle Vettovaglie hosts a busy daily market, offering tourists all kinds of products and a picturesque glimpse of Tuscan lifestyle.



# SPORT & FITNESS

## CUS Pisa



The *Centro Sportivo Universitario* (CUS Pisa) organizes a wide variety of team and individual sport courses.

Course enrolling is reserved to users possessing the CUS Pisa Card and regularly registered.

The courses are mainly aimed at university students in Pisa, who can also take advantage of a number of discounts when booking courts for Volleyball, Basketball, Tennis, Beach Volleyball, Futsal, Football and Table Tennis.

# CHOIR & ORCHESTRA



The University of Pisa Choir, established in the academic year 1999/2000, and the University of Pisa Orchestra, established in the academic year 2010/2011, are both composed of students of the University, including international students from all over the world.

Also open to the participation of professors and staff, the Choir and the Orchestra, each engaged in its own concert activity, every year organise together the traditional Christmas Concert.

Since 2021, the Choir and Orchestra have formed the "Maria Antonella Galanti" Music Centre, which is part of the new Centre for Innovation and the Diffusion of Culture (CIDIC).

Participation in the Choir is free of charge and no special musical knowledge is required.

The prerequisite of correct pitch of the sounds is required, which is verified with a simple vocal test.

### ***Pisa by bike***

CicloPi is a bike sharing service, which offers a real alternative to the car for moving around town. With its 200 circulating bicycles, CicloPi is the most practical form of urban transport in terms of both time and costs.

15 docking stations, placed in the main strategic points in Pisa, offer provide visitors with an exciting and convenient way to explore Pisa beauties.

Students can get a pass by signing up online.

# USEFUL PHONE NUMBERS

## *Single European emergency number 112*

In Tuscany, the **Nue 112** (Single Emergency Number 112) is active. This service allows, by dialling a single number, 1 1 2 (one, one, two), to request the intervention of the State Police, Carabinieri, Fire Brigade or Health Service.



Calls to the single European emergency number, 112, are free of charge from landlines and mobile networks, even if the phone does not have a SIM card, is blocked or is out of credit.

The number can be reached via the [WHERE ARE U](#) app as well. The operators have the caller's phone number immediately available and can see his/her location on a map. Even if the caller speaks a foreign language, he/she can explain what is needed thanks to the multilingual service, which allows simultaneous translation of the call with the help of an interpreter.
